1. State of Tourist Facilities in the Towns and Cities after the Disaster

(1) Toyo Region

○Shikoku Chuo City, Niihama City, Saijo City: No outstanding damages to any primary tourist facilities

○Imabari City: One of the tourist facilities in Omishima was temporarily closed due to issues with the road on the island. The facility has been re-opened as of 7/15.

○Kamishima Town: Due to a town water outage, the tourist facilities were shut down. The facilities have been re-opened as of 7/19.

(2) Chuyo Region

○Matsuyama City, Toon City, Kumakogen Town, Tobe Town, Iyo City: No outstanding damages to any primary tourist facilities.

(3) Nanyo Region

○Uchiko Town, Yawatahama City, Ikata Town, Kihoku Town, Ainan Town: No outstanding damages to any primary tourist facilities.

○Ozu City: No outstanding damages to Garyu Sanso or Ozu Castle. Several other tourist facilities have been temporarily closed.

○Seiyo City: Several tourist facilities have been temporarily closed.

○Matsuno Town: Mori no Kuni Hotel (Forest Kingdom Hotel) and Niji no Mori Park (Rainbow Forest Park) have been temporarily closed.

○Uwajima City: The Azechi Umetaro & Iseki Kunisaburo Memorial Museums, Haraigawa Onsen, and Kinahaiya Sanmangoku have been temporarily closed. Other tourist facilities are running normally.
